**BRUNEI FISHERY LIMITS ACT
(CAP. 130)**

BRUNEI FISHERY LIMITS ORDER

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 3(3) of the Brunei Fishery Limits Act, His Majesty The Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan of Brunei Darussalam has made the following Order —

- Citation.** 1. This Order may be cited as the Brunei Fishery Limits Order.
- Brunei Fishery Limits.** 2. Pursuant to section 3(3) of the Brunei Fishery Limits Act, the fishery limits of Brunei Darussalam shall be :
- an outer-limit consisting of a line 200 miles distant from the base-line from which the breadth of the territorial sea of Brunei is measured ;
 - a lateral boundary with the adjoining territory of Sabah, consisting of the same boundary as was promulgated for the continental shelf of North Borneo by Order-in-Council of 11th September 1958 (S. 1 1958 No. 1517) but continued out to the 200-mile limit by a straight line ;
 - a lateral boundary with the adjoining territory of Sarawak, consisting of the same boundary as was promulgated for the continental shelf of Sarawak by Order-in-Council of 11th September 1958 (S. 1 1958 No. 1518) but continued out to the 200-mile limit by a straight line.
- Large scale map.** 3. The limits indicated in paragraph 2 of this Order are depicted on a large scale map Series : Misc. 1 Edition : 1 JUAB Sheet 3 which is deposited in the office of the Surveyor-General.
